## **Bedford Township Parks Regulations and**

## **Bedford Public Schools Use of Grounds Regulations**

- 1. The authorized representative who signs the permit must be a Bedford resident at least 18 years of age, and must be present during the time requested.
- 2. The permit holder accepts full responsibility for the orderly conduct of the persons who attend the function and for any damage to park or school property.
- 3. Please cancel permit if you no longer wish to use the diamond or field reserved.
- 4. No gambling is permitted.
- 5. Admittance fees are not permitted.
- 6. Commercial demonstrations are prohibited.
- 7. Intoxicating beverages are prohibited.
- 8. No vehicles may be parked on the grass areas. Motorized vehicles are prohibited from play areas.
- 9. Premises will be left in the same conditions as when reserved.
- 11. Permits will be **issued only for the dates, hours, areas specified**. Permit holders shall not transfer or sublet the permit to another organization.
- 12. Diamond permits will be approved for one night a week at a time, Monday thru Friday between 5:30-7:00 pm or 7:00-8:30pm. Saturdays are available for extended periods of time.
- 13. Permit holder & all parties involved agrees to indemnify and HOLD HARMLESS Bedford Public Schools Board of Education and their agents and employees from all liability, claims demands, or costs, for/or arising out of the use of this building under this building permit, whether it be caused by the negligence of indemnitor on Bedford Public Schools of Education or either party's agents or employees.
- 14. Failure to abide by the rules and regulations of this agreement may result in denial of future permits for park use and/or appropriate legal action.
